NOTICE OF ADDENDUM COMPLETION

BACKGROUND & PURPOSE OF ADDENDUM

On January 24th, 2013, the Township of Adjala-Tosorontio (Township) issued a notice of completion for the Community of Everett Master Servicing Plan (MSP) which addressed Transportation, Stormwater Management, and Water and Wastewater Servicing issues within the study area (see the map provided in this notice) in accordance with the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) process.

Since the completion of the Everett MSP and a subsequent Schedule 'C' Class EA for the Everett Wastewater Treatment Plant & Surface Water Outfall, additional wastewater conveyance solutions and technologies have come to the Township's attention; specifically, a low-slope gravity sewer system with lot-level pre-treatment. This technology requires proper evaluation against the previously selected Everett MSP wastewater conveyance solution before being considered as a potential servicing solution, in accordance with Environmental Assessment Act.

As such, this Addendum was completed to evaluate the viability of low-slope gravity sewers with lot-level pre-treatment, in accordance with the recommendations of the Class EA process against the previously selected sewage collection and disposal technology.

It should be noted that this Addendum applies only to the wastewater conveyance component of the Everett MSP, and does not affect the recommendations of the MSP (transportation, water or stormwater management) or the Schedule 'C' WWTP & Surface Water Outfall Class EA.

PROCESS

A comparative evaluation was completed between conventional gravity based conveyance technologies and the newly proposed low-slope gravity sewer systems with lot-level pretreatment. This evaluation found that although both options had different advantages and disadvantages, both technologies were equally viable for the purpose of achieving the servicing goals outlined in the Everett MSP preferred sanitary servicing solution

Subject to comments received as a result of this notice, the Township will be able to proceed with the implementation of the recommended Schedule A, A+ and B projects included in the Class EA Master Plan Study Report.

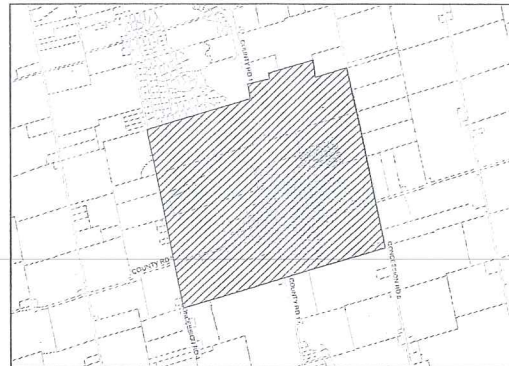
PUBLIC COMMENT INVITED
