TAXATION INFORMATION

Tax bills are issued twice per year with each bill having two instalment due dates. The Interim Tax Bill is based on 50% of your prior year total taxes. Payments must be received on or before the due date. It is the property owner's responsibility to ensure payments are received by the due date. Late payment charges are subject to penalties of 1.25% added on the first day of default. Staff do not have the authority to waive penalty charges. Canada Post is not an agent for the municipality; therefore, penalty cannot be waived if the payment is not received on time.

Payment Options

- **Financial Institutions**-Taxes can be paid via telephone banking, online banking or in person at the branch
- **In Person**-At the Municipal Centre if paying by cheque, cash or debit
- **After Hours Drop Box**-Located at the Municipal Centre front door entrance (cheques only)
- **Mail**-Please make cheques payable to the *Township of Adjala-Tosorontio* and allow sufficient time for mailing prior to the due date. Post-dated cheques are accepted
- **Pre-Authorized Payment Plan**-Visit www.adjtos.ca to download an application

ASSESSMENT INFORMATION

The Municipal Property Assessment Corporation (MPAC) is responsible for assessing and classifying all properties within the Township.

MPAC updates property values every four years. Property assessment notices were last mailed in 2016 and serve as the basis for calculating property taxes for 2017-2020.

Five factors account for 85% of your home's value including: location; living area; age of property; lot dimensions; and quality of construction.

Accurate assessed values are the cornerstone of the property tax system. Ask yourself if you could sell your property for the assessed value. If you answer "yes" then your assessed value is accurate.

If you answer "no" then visit www.aboutmyproperty.ca to learn more about how your property was assessed. If you disagree with the value or classification, you have the option to file a Request for Reconsideration (RfR). The deadline to submit an RfR should be confirmed with MPAC.
