Re: TOWNSHIP OF ADJALA-TOSORONTIO

Mandatory On-Site Sewage System Maintenance Inspection

Effective on January 1st, 2011, the Ontario Building Code was amended by Ontario Regulation 315/10 to establish and govern Mandatory On-Site Sewage System Maintenance Inspection Program to be administered by municipalities in Ontario every 5 years.

There are **two components** of the re-inspection program.

- 1. The <u>first</u> component is a visual surface inspection of your sewage system, which will be conducted by the Township of Adjala-Tosorontio Building department between August 1, 2022 October 30, 2022. The property owner does not need to be in attendance for this inspection. The cost will be \$150, payable to the Township of Adjala-Tosorontio no later than **October 30th**, 2022, of invoicing (Invoice enclosed). If a deficiency is noted during the inspection, the property owner(s) will be notified in writing by the Township of Adjala-Tosorontio and they must take the necessary steps to correct the deficiency within the timeframe stipulated.
- 2. The <u>second</u> component is having your septic or holding tank pumped out and inspected by a licensed sewage hauler. This is your **responsibility for arranging**. The sewage hauler **must** provide you with a report confirming the date of the pump-out and both the condition of the tank and size of the tank (report enclosed). The report must be signed by the septic hauler and **be submitted** to the Township of Adjala-Tosorontio, no later than **October 30**th, **2022**. Reports from the last two years are acceptable.

Advanced Treatment Units - Every treatment unit must supply the Township with its service agreement and the annual service reports which must be sent into the township every year. If you do not have a Current Service Agreement or do not submit the mandatory Annual Service Reports; you will be inspected by the Township, be charged \$150.00 for the annual inspection, and required to provide Service Agreement at a later date.

If the two components or the advanced treatment requirements are not completed, further action may be required.
