



We are a few months into 2024 and things are moving along at a good pace in the Township. Council and Staff are putting in a lot of effort to enhance our services, infrastructure, communication, and are laying groundwork for our future.

I am pleased with the progress over the past year and excited about things to come this year. Work continues on several plans and studies including, our Strategic Plan, Parks Master Plan, Fire Master Plan and an update to our Roads Need Study.

These projects will be completed this year and the recommendations will start to be implemented over this term of Council. The plans and studies will help us to make the best investments in our community for your tax dollars.

Over the course of this year, you will see a number of infrastructure projects begin. Works will include paving of Concession Road 3 Tosorontio between the 5th Sideroad north to County Road 5, culvert work and paving on Concession Road 7 Adjala from Keenansville Road north to County Road 1, and road microsurfacing in several of our hamlets improving the roads in our subdivisions. We will also continue with various asphalt repairs, gravel road maintenance and some ditching operations.

We have seen the development of the subdivisions in the Colgan community progress quickly and a number of new homes have been built. Occupancies are continuing over the next couple of years. The Township has provided a 'New Residents Package' for anyone who has moved to our community. The package includes valuable information on our services, Staff and Council contacts, health care and school contacts, waste management information and maps. You may pick up one of these packages at the Township office. To those new to the Township – Welcome!
