Second Work in Simcoe County Virtual Job Fair on November 9 Job seekers can register today

Midhurst/ November 4, 2021 – Following the success of the County's first Virtual Job Fair in June 2021, the County and area partners are offering another online "Work in Simcoe County" Job Fair on Tuesday, November 9 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Data collected from the County of Simcoe's Work in Simcoe County website, workinsimcoecounty.ca, shows that in the month of September, there were 9,523 active job openings in our region. More than 80 employers have registered for the Job Fair so far, including Simcoe County District School Board, Vetta Nordic Spa, Town of Innisfil, Mount St. Louis Moonstone Ski Resort, Napoleon, Linear Transfer Automation, Orillia Soldiers Memorial Hospital, 400 Chrysler Barrie, and Georgian Bay General Hospital, among many others. The event is to be hosted on an interactive, user-friendly platform that will connect job seekers and employers through one-on-one text chat, audio and video. Employment opportunities from the following sectors are available: manufacturing and distribution; agriculture and food processing; healthcare and social assistance; transportation; hospitality and tourism; construction and the trades; education and training; not for profit organizations; retail and professional services.

Job seekers are also encouraged to register early to view companies and job opportunities in advance. As an additional service, job seekers can access one-on-one support from Employment Ontario partners prior to the event, including free assistance with resume writing, developing a job search plan and preparing for interviews.
