Introduction

This guide has been prepared for the purpose of supplying information to persons intending to stand for elected office and is available electronically on the Township of Adjala-Tosorontio website.

This guide is only intended to provide candidates with information on running for office. Candidates are responsible for ensuring they are familiar with the requirements of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 and should consult the Act for complete information and legislative requirements. A copy of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 is available online at www.Ontario.ca/laws.

Candidates must comply with all the requirements relating to election campaign financing. The Ministry of Municipal Affairs produces a guide for candidates that outlines the financial reporting requirements under the Act which has been included.

This guide may be updated periodically. Please notify the Clerk's Department of any changes to your email address.

It is the responsibility of prospective candidates to ensure through their own determination that they have complied with the election financing regulations and that they are in fact qualified and not disqualified by law. In all cases of filing times (i.e.: 2:00 p.m.), the tie displayed by the Clerk's Department clock shall prevail.

Municipal Offices to Be Elected

On Monday, October 24, 2022, voters in the Township of Adjala-Tosorontio will elect members for the following offices:

Mayor

One to be elected by all electors of the municipality

Deputy Mayor

One to be elected by all electors of the municipality

Councillor - Ward 1

One to be elected by electors in Ward 1 in the municipality

Councillor - Ward 2

One to be elected by electors in Ward 2 in the municipality

Councillor - Ward 3

One to be elected by electors in Ward 3 in the municipality

Councillor – Ward 4

One to be elected by electors in Ward 4 in the municipality

Councillor - Ward 5

One to be elected by electors in Ward 5 in the municipality

Simcoe County District School Board (English-Public)

- One to be elected by public school board electors of the municipality
- To be filed at the Township of Essa

Simcoe Muskoka Catholic District School Board (English-Separate)

- One to be elected by separate school electors of the municipality
- To be filed at the Town of New Tecumseth

Conseil Scolaire Viamond (French-Public)

- One to be elected by French language public school electors of the municipality
- To be filed at the City of Barrie

Conseil Scolaire Catholique MonAvenir (French-Separate)

- One to be elected by French language separate school electors of the municipality
- To be filed at the City of Barrie

Qualification of Candidates

Member of Council

Qualifications for members of Council are set out in Section 256 of the Municipal Act, 2001 and Section 17 of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996.

In order to run for office in the Township of Adjala-Tosorontio a person must be:

- 1. A Canadian citizen;
- 2. At least 18 years old;
- 3. A resident of the Township of Adjala-Tosorontio or the owner or tenant of land here, or the spouse of such owner or tenant; and
- 4. Who is not disqualified by any legislation from holding office.

Ineligibility

The following are ineligible to be elected as members of Council:

- (a) An employee of the Township of Adjala-Tosorontio except during an authorized leave of absence (the leave of absence must begin upon filing the Nomination Form);
- (b) A person who is not an employee of the municipality but who is the Clerk, Treasurer, Integrity Commissioner, Auditor General, Ombudsman or Registrar, or who holds any administrative position of the municipality;
- (c) A judge of any court;
- (d) A member of the Assembly as provided in the Legislative Assembly Act or of the Senate or House of Commons of Canada.
