**A BY-LAW TO REGULATE PARKING IN THE TOWNSHIP  
OF ADJALA-TOSORONTIO**

Parking By-law

**WHEREAS** the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, Chapter 25, as amended, provides in section 11 that Municipalities may pass By-laws respecting highways including parking and traffic on highways; provides in section 27 that a Municipality may pass By-laws in respect of a highway only if it has jurisdiction over the highway; provides in section 28 that a local Municipality has jurisdiction over all road allowances, highways, streets and lanes located in the Municipality; and provides in section 63 for prohibiting or regulating the placing, stopping, standing or parking of an object or vehicle on a highway, it may provide for the removal and impounding or restraining and immobilizing of any object or vehicle placed, stopped, standing or parked on a highway in contravention of the By-law and subsection 170(5) of the Highway Traffic Act, as amended, applies to the By-law;

**AND WHEREAS** the Highway Traffic Act, Chapter H.8, as amended, provides in section 12 that no person shall park or stand a vehicle on a highway in such a manner as to interfere with the movement of traffic or the clearing of snow from the highway and provides in section 15 that a police officer, police cadet, municipal law enforcement officer or an officer appointed for the carrying out of the provisions of this Act, upon discovery of any vehicle parked or standing in contravention of a Municipal By-law, may cause it to be moved or taken to and placed or stored in a suitable place and all costs and charges for removing, care and storage thereof, if any, area lien upon the vehicle, which may be enforced in the manner provided by the Repair and Storage Liens Act;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Adjala-Tosorontio deems it appropriate to pass a By-law to regulate parking on highways in the Municipality;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Adjala-Tosorontio enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** the definition of words in this By-law are as provided in the Highway Traffic Act;
2. **THAT**, where signs are posted, the stopping, parking or standing of vehicles is prohibited within 100 metres of any municipal bridge located on any municipal highway, street, road allowance or right-of-way;
3. **THAT**, where signs are posted, the parking or standing of vehicles is prohibited on the parts of municipal highways listed on Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this By-law;
4. **THAT** the parking or standing of vehicles is prohibited on any municipal highway, street, road allowance or right-of-way during the winter control period December 1 to April 15.
5. **THAT** vehicles parked or standing on a highway in such a manner as to interfere with the movement of traffic may be moved as provided for in the Highway Traffic Act;
6. **THAT** every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this By-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act;
7. **THAT** where a person is charged pursuant to this By-law and the person does not wish to dispute the charge they may deliver the parking infraction notice and the amount of the set fine, as set out in Schedule "B" to this By-law to the Administration Centre of Township of Adjala-Tosorontio, in person or by mail, within ten days from the date of the alleged offence and upon such payment no further proceedings shall be taken under this By-law in respect of the said offence;
8. THAT By-law 96-55 is hereby repealed;
9. THAT this By-law shall come into force and effect upon third reading and passage;
10. THAT, notwithstanding anything contrary to the rules of procedure, this By-law be introduced and read a first and second time and be considered read a third time and finally passed this 5th day of April 2004.

1.	Stopping, parking or standing within 100 metres of bridge	1	\$100.00
2.	Stopping, parking or standing as listed on Schedule "A"	2	\$100.00
3.	Parking or standing during winter control period	3	\$100.00
